

Reach University is an accredited, nonprofit university offering *bachelor's degrees* for school employees.

Reach's Apprenticeship Degree undergraduate program is built for working adults. Candidates earn college credit while working at a partner K-12 district. Online seminars are scheduled after work hours.

After grants and scholarships, the expected out-of-pocket contribution for full-time undergraduate candidates is \$75 per month throughout the degree experience – with zero student loan debt.
