Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies

Program Duration & Transfer Credit Policy

The length of time to complete the degree depends on the number of transfer-level college credits earned by the candidate prior to enrollment.

Candidates entering with **zero college credits** will complete the degree in:

4
years

Candidates transferring **30 college credits** will complete the degree in:

3
years

Candidates entering with a conferred **associate degree** will complete the degree in:

2
years

Upon completion of a B.A. in Liberal Studies degree, candidates interested in becoming a teacher will need to enroll in a state-approved alternative certification program.

Bachelor of Arts in Global Education + Institutional Recommendation for Licensure

The 4-year program includes a clinical residency in the fourth year. Candidates seeking licensure must engage in 15 hours per week of supervised teaching with a Mentor Teacher.
