B.A. Program

Created specifically for classified employees, the Apprenticeship Degree B.A. program ensures school employees can earn credit for work they do on the job while completing Zoom seminars after work hours. After grants and scholarships, the expected out-ofpocket contribution for full-time undergraduate candidates is **\$75 per month, with zero student loan debt.**

Intern/M.A.T. Program

The Intern Teacher/M.A.T. program allows qualified bachelor's degree holders to serve as a teacher of record in a California public school while earning a preliminary single- or multiple-subject credential and M.A.T. after work hours. The cost of the program is \$7,500 per year.

Teacher Induction Program

Teacher Induction is a two-year, individualized, jobembedded program of mentoring, support, and professional learning for beginning teachers, fully aligned to the California Standards for the Teaching Profession (CSTP). The cost of the program includes tuition and a mentor: \$4,500/year for the two-year pathway and \$5,000/year for Early Completion Option (ECO).
