





REACH ACADEMIC DETAILS





Foundation Year Redesign: Clear Connections

- More aligned to structures of other semesters so learning experiences are continual
- Clearer connections to job-embedded tasks and experiences



Craft Connect: Streamlined Process

- Weekly Hours Now Verified ONCE at the beginning and ONCE at the end of the Semester by HR
- Competencies and Capstones will be tracked and verified at the end of the semester
- Access for more viewers



Clinical Residency: Here we go!

- Year-long (with gradual release leading up to semester of teaching)
- If a candidate's teaching status changes, ensure they are in compliance with LDOE requirements (e.g., passed licensure).



Semester of Literacy: Policy Alignment

• Course content is aligned to state literacy (science of reading) and dyslexia policy requirements.
